Ed-endings have three different pronunciations:

/d/

- used after voiced sounds

Ex: play – *played*

(**NOT** pronounced as an extra syllable)

- loved
- opened
- studied
- failed
- climbed

/t/

- used after unvoiced sounds

/k/ /f/ /p/ /s/ /ks/ /sh/ /tsh/

Ex: pack – *packed*

(**NOT** pronounced as an extra syllable)

- laughed
- finished
- jumped
- watched
- kissed

/id/

- used after the final sounds

/d/ and /t/

Ex: need – *needed*

(**PRONOUNCED** as an extra syllable)

- waited
- started
- invented
- painted
- ended

Note: a few verbs are pronounced and spelt /d/ or /t/ - *learned/learnt; burned/burnt*

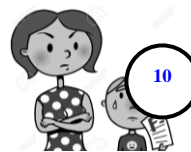

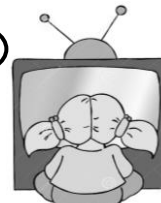

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Traducción del texto "An internet sensation"

Una sensación de internet

Todos los años, los astronautas viajan a la Estación Espacial Internacional y viven en órbita durante unos seis meses. Un astronauta canadiense, Chris Hadfield, fue famoso mientras estaba en el espacio.

Hadfield usó Internet para enviar videos desde la estación espacial al público en general en la Tierra. Describió su vida y actividades cotidianas. No usaba un traje espacial en muchas de sus videos, estaba en una camiseta normal, por lo que fue increíble pensar que estaba en el espacio. Pero algunas cosas no eran normales. En un video, intentó hacer un sándwich. No fue fácil: ¡el pan flotaba en el aire!

Hadfield ama la fotografía y usó su cámara digital para tomar fotos de la Tierra desde una perspectiva inusual, por ejemplo, cuando el volcán Etna de Italia entró en erupción. Hadfield también es músico. Mucha gente lo vio en video tocando su guitarra en el espacio y cantando Space Oddity, una canción de la estrella del pop David Bowie.

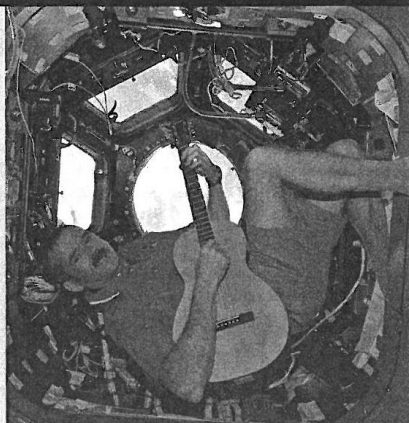
Reading

EVERY YEAR, astronauts travel to the International Space Station and live in orbit for about six months. One Canadian astronaut, Chris Hadfield, was famous while he was in space.

Hadfield used the internet to send videos from the space station to the general public on Earth. He described his life and everyday activities. He didn't wear a spacesuit in many of his videos – he was in a normal T-shirt – so it was amazing to think that he was in space. But some things weren't normal. In one video, he tried to make a sandwich. It wasn't easy – the bread floated in the air!

Hadfield loves photography and he used his digital camera to take photos of Earth from an unusual perspective, for example, when Italy's volcano Mount Etna erupted. Hadfield is also a musician. Lots of people watched him on video playing his guitar in space and singing *Space Oddity*, a song by the pop star David Bowie.
