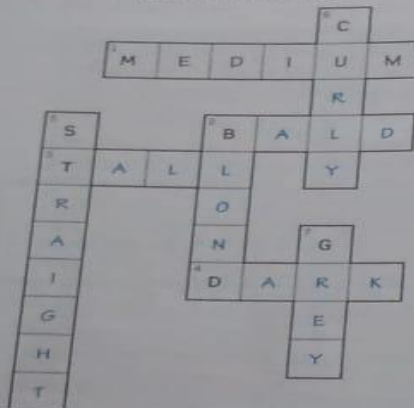

Ed-endings have three different pronunciations:

/d/

- used after voiced sounds

Ex: play – *played*

(**NOT** pronounced as an extra syllable)

- loved
- opened
- studied
- failed
- climbed

/t/

- used after unvoiced sounds

/k/ /f/ /p/ /s/ /ks/ /sh/ /tsh/

Ex: pack – *packed*

(**NOT** pronounced as an extra syllable)

- laughed
- finished
- jumped
- watched
- kissed

/id/

- used after the final sounds

/d/ and /t/

Ex: need – *needed*

(**PRONOUNCED** as an extra syllable)

- waited
- started
- invented
- painted
- ended

**Note:** a few verbs are pronounced and spelt /d/ or /t/ - learned/learnt; burned/burnt

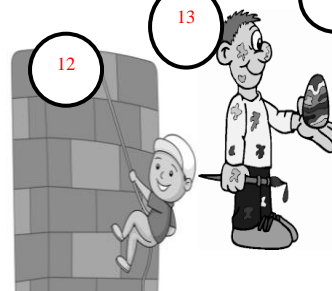
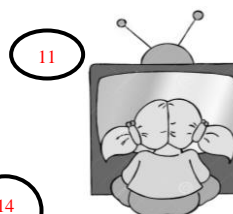
